
Bicycle Regulations

It is important that you lock and fasten your bicycle to bicycle racks in designated areas **ONLY**.

IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT PARKING YOUR BICYCLE

- Illegally parked bicycles that obstruct walkways, stairs, and ramps present potential hazards for people with mobility issues and/or visual impairments. If your bicycle is illegally parked in this manner, it may be impounded.
- Do **NOT** lock or fasten bicycles to trees, shrubs, lamp posts, handrails, bus shelters, school signs, fences, or benches.
- Bicycles are **NOT** allowed in buildings. Staff may utilize the bicycle racks located in CPS garages (i.e. CRLS, MLK/PAUS, and King Open/CSUS). Students are **NOT** allowed to utilize the staff garage.
- Bicycles that are deemed abandoned may be impounded.

The Department of Safety & Security is not liable for securing devices or locks that are damaged during impoundment. Contact the Department of Safety & Security at 617.349.6772 if you have any questions related to this policy or to verify that your bike has been impounded.
